I. VIOLATIONS:

Consumption of alcohol.

Urine specimens submitted by subject on August 23rd, August 31st, September 6th, September 9th, and September 16th, were positive for alcohol.

On September 28, 1989, and October 6, 1989, subject admitted to the undersigned that he continued to drink alcohol. He stated that he could not promise to discontinue its use. On September 28, 1989, the undersigned probation officer urged subject to seek admission to an alcohol recovery home, which would cost him approximately \$500 a month, and which he would pay from his earnings. Subject stated that he could not afford to do so. On October 6, 1989, the undersigned explored with subject the possibility of entering Impact House, Pasadena, a contract drug program. Subject stated that he did not want to enter any kind of a residential drug or alcohol program, either contract or non-contract. He states that he attends AA meetings once a week, in compliance with the probation officer's instructions. Participants of these meetings usually introduce themselves and acknowledge that they are alcoholics or drug addicts. Subject states that when his turn comes, he introduces himself, but does not admit that he is an alcoholic or drug addict.

Subject has expressed deep resentment regarding the Parole Commission's order that he not consume any alcohol. On October 10, 1989, he stated "If I do no drugs and no crime, I'm doing good... what do you people want of me?" Subject indicated that he did not intend to discontinue drinking alcohol at any time in the future, and stated that because of this he would probably be returned to prison for violations for various periods of time between now and the scheduled expiration date in 2001.

Our reasons for recommending an order that subject not consume any alcohol are stated in our Violation Report of June 16, 1989. By Notice of Action dated July 11, 1989, subject was ordered not to consume any alcohol. It is felt that his continuing to drink makes him a threat to the community. It is recommended that a warrant be issued.
